NOTIFICATION

Noida, the 20th October, 2011

G.S.R. 780(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Group 'C' and Group 'D' Non-Technical posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988, in so far as it relates to the posts of Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk, in the Ministry of Shipping, Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Shipping, Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk, Group 'C' Posts, Recruitment Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.** - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.** - The number of posts, their classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Disqualifications.** - No person -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

2. Promotion on the basis of Limited Department Competitive Examination:- Lower Division Clerk with five years regular service in the pay band of ₹ 5200-20200 plus grade pay ₹ 1900 and qualify the limited Departmental Competitive Examination.

Syllabus for Limited Department Competitive Examination namely:-

- (a) essay writing and precise writing – 100 marks;
 - (b) noting and drafting – 100 marks;
 - (c) knowledge of office procedure, financial and service rules – 100 marks;
 - (d) assessment of Annual Confidential Reports/Annual Appraisal Report – 100 marks; and
3. Deputation:- Officers of the Central Government:
- (i) post on regular basis; or

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(ii) with eight years regular service in the grade of Lower Division Clerk or equivalent.

Note 1.—The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2.—Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.

Note 3.—The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.

Note 4.—For the purpose of appointment on deputation or absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Sixth Central Commission recommendation has been
